**DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT**

This project involved the design of a county-owned, 155-acre regional park and sports facility located south of South Mobley Road and east of Race Track Road in Hillsborough County, Florida. Project objectives included the design of the County's largest park facility, justification of unavoidable wetland impacts, permitting, and wetland mitigation design. Scheda's ecologists performed habitat characterizations, wetland jurisdictional determinations, wetland mitigation design (grading and planting plans, details, and specifications), and obtained all environmental permits, which includes the design of a wildlife corridor. This project was jointly funded by Hillsborough County and the Southwest Florida Water Management District's Basin Board. This regional sports complex has won numerous site design awards:
